Tanya Gouveia holds two Masters Degrees in Crime & Justice and in Public Administration from Suffolk University in Boston. She is also a Licensed Chemical Dependency Professional-II in the state of RI and a Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor-I in the state of MA. Her work experience began within the Massachusetts and Rhode Island Correctional settings providing substance abuse education to the incarcerated population. Throughout her career she has also worked in collaboration with multiple agencies including Adult Probation and Parole, Department of Children and Families, Department of Mental Health and Drug Courts to name a few. After cannabis legislation passed Tanya began researching and created a curriculum to best service our clients without shattering the therapeutic relationship by challenging their position on cannabis. Since then she has presented on cannabis education and prevention to our clients, the Department of Children and Families and other agencies. Currently she is an outpatient substance abuse therapist with AdCare Hospital in Dartmouth, MA and provides clinical care to adults and their families. She is also an adjunct professor with Bristol Community College teaching Community Counseling & Case Management through the Substance Abuse Certificate Program.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- 1.) **Understand the Cannabis Climate: What is it? Who is the targeted population? How does it impact treatment for dual diagnosis clients?**
- 2.) **Facts Vs. Fiction: What do we know for certain about cannabis use, potential benefits or harm?**
- 3.) **Legality: What is the law? How are we liable as clinicians and what is our responsibility to our clients?**

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

This workshop is geared toward identifying different types of cannabis use and its impact on the mind and body both short term and long term. Participants will also be able to understand the legal concepts regarding cannabis use and the liability towards the clinician treating their clients. They will also be given examples of best practices to help treat clients who are still ambivalent about stopping cannabis use and how to properly engage the client to consider how cannabis can effect long term recovery results.
