### Agenda & Minutes

- 1. The meeting was promptly called to order, a motion was made to accept last month's minutes and voted upon unanimously.
- 2. Motion made to elect Devin Stevenson and Christine Kelly as full voting members of the Executive Board, voted unanimously.
- 3. <u>Regional Meetings</u>: Meetings held for most MAADAC Regions, and a slate of officers submitted to the Executive Board.
- 4. <u>Membership Survey:</u> James Plaza reported that Mail Chimp has a free service for conducting a survey for the membership. Received 9 questions for membership and reviewed in the group. Will move forward with survey.
- 5. <u>President's Report</u>: Joe attended the NAADAC Annual Meeting, noted some changes in NAADAC leadership, Cynthia Maroney-Touey has left position. Don Johnson received the NAADAC Lora Roe Counselor of the Year Award.
- 6. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Linda reported a positive balance in the MAADAC account; indicated that the web site fee is \$125 per month; there is also an annual \$300 domain charge. MAADAC Business cards are being developed.
- 7. <u>LADC-1 Scope of Practice</u>: Recent posts to the NAADAC Massachusetts
  Community Discussion Board raised the question of ability of LADC-1's to
  diagnose and treat mental illness. According to BSAS and the 105 CMR
  Regulations that govern the licensing of alcohol and drug counselors, LADC-1's
  are not permitted to either diagnose or treat persons with co-occurring disorders
  (mental illness and substance use disorders) unless they are dually licensed as an

LMHC, LICSW, LMFT, or other designated health occupations. LADC-1's may be able to provide such clinical services if they are working under the license of an approved provider or agency. Otherwise, the LADC-1 may be liable! We will draft a letter of concern that recommends changes to the Regulations, review at next Borad meeting, and then forward to the Director of BSAS
